WHAT IS LES 5 ÉTOILES DE PAU?



Les 5 Etoiles de Pau is a 5* international eventing class, the only competition of its kind in France that brings together the world's leading horse-rider pairs every year: 4 days where the pace of events is as breathtaking as the speed of the world-renowned horses as they gallop along. An unmissable and unforgettable event, in a warm and friendly atmosphere.

Les 5 Etoiles de Pau is also an event for all the family:

- The 4-Nations Tournament: international horse-ball tournament.
- Exhibitors' village and foodcourt with food-trucks and craft products.
- Entertainment and events for everyone.



A SPECTACULAR TRIATHLON

The eventing competition is an equestrian triathlon that requires high-performance from both riders and horses in all the different tests, which offers an amazing show and nail-biting suspense!

1. DRESSAGE

A highly technical test designed to assess the harmony between horse and rider, as well as the rider's mastery of all the horse's movements. Elegance, shine and skill are required to getting the best out of the game and earn some coveted points.

2. CROSS-COUNTRY

The highlight of the eventing competition: setting off at full gallop for 11 minutes along a 6,500 km course in the natural landscape, the horse-rider combinations have to tackle the 45 impressive fixed obstacles (up to 1.40 m high). Throughout this unmissable event combining speed, adrenaline and stamina, excitement runs high among the crowds lining the cross-country course in a festive atmosphere.

HORSE INSPECTIONS

Two key moments in eventing: before the start of the competition and the day after the cross-country, the vets assess the health, condition and aptitude of each horse to tackle the series of tests that lie ahead. The slightest doubt as to a horse's physical integrity sees it eliminated from the competition.

3. SHOW JUMPING

This is the final pinnacle test in the competition, and the competitors who completed the gruelling cross-country course will have to show their technical expertise over a series of fences - each time they touch a rail, it could fall, docking points off the total score and upset the leaderboard right to the last second! Did someone mention suspense?

Sunday

Pau is part of the highly exclusive CCI 5*L club: Only 7 competitions in the world have this label, which represents the highest possible grade in equestrian sports. Completing the entire competition is a real achievement for all the riders, and Pau is one of the rare legendary events that is famous across the continents. And the biggest names will be in Pau this year...

BATTLE OF THE CHAMPIONS

The top international eventing riders have announced their participation at the 5 Etoiles de Pau. They include the top riders on the FEI world ranking list: Oliver Townend (GBR, winner at Burghley and Olympic team gold), Ros Canter (GBR, winner at Badminton and European champion), Boyd Martin (USA) and Tim Price (NZL, winner in Pau in 2021). With Tom McEwen (GBR, winner in Pau in 2019, Olympic team gold and silver individual medallist), Harry Meade (GBR), William Oakden (GBR) and Phillip Dutton (USA), eight of the top 10 world riders will be battling it out in Pau for this final competition of this year's eventing season.

12 NATIONS, 5 CONTINENTS...ONE TROPHY

Riders from all over the world will be flocking to Pau for a 2023 that promises to be exceptional and full of suspense. There will be a large cohort of British riders, including the biggest names in eventing (Pippa Funnel, Piggy March, Tom Jackson and Alex Bragg, to name but a few). But they'll have to contend with experienced riders from other countries too! The delegations from New Zealand (including Jonelle Price, winner in Pau in 2022), Ireland and the USA are in particularly good shape, and are sending their best horse-rider pairs to compete. Not forgetting Japan, Australia, Switzerland, Belgium, Austria, Lithuania, Zimbabwe, Spain - and France of course! Eight French riders will be on the start list, including Gaspard Maksud (bronze team medallist at the last European Championships, and 6th individual at the World Championships). A fierce competition is on the cards, and the suspense will keep the crowds on the edge of their seats until the end! At less than a year before the Paris Olympic Games, the results in Pau could really shake up the ranking!





^{*} CCI 5*- L: International 5-Star Eventing Competition (Long). International equestrian competitions are star-rated from 1* (the lowest grade) to 5* (the highest grade, like the Pau 5* event). The format can be either long (L) or short (S) and this refers to the length of the cross-country course and the number of efforts to jump over.

THE 4-NATIONS TOURNAMENT

Though the name evokes rugby, this tournament is an equestrian one! Les 5 Etoiles de Pau will be hosting an international horse-ball tournament that should create a great sporting atmosphere in the main arena.

A TEAM SPORT

Horse-ball is gaining ground fast in the world of equestrian sports. In each match, two teams play against each other using a ball with leather handles, and the aim is to score as many goals as possible against the opposing team. Speed, fast reactions and team spirit are required to compete in this discipline. It's spectator-friendly and fast-paced, and the matches are full of suspense as the tables can turn at any time! Spectators at the main arena will almost feel like they're in a rugby stadium with the electric atmosphere.

A TOP-OF-THE LEAGUE COMPETITION

For this 4-Nations Tournament, some of the biggest names in the sport will be competing against one another. Four national teams, currently ranked among the best in the world, will compete against one another: the United Kingdom, Spain, Italy and, of course, France. We're expecting the crowds to be huge to encourage the teams in this very first edition of the tournament. Which nation will raise the trophy?



ANDY BOOTH: A HORSE WHISPERER IN EQUESTRIAN SPORTS

INTERNATIONALLY RENOWNED

Andy Booth needs no introduction! An Australian, world-renowned horse instructor and professional rider, Andy Booth settled in France in 2001. He introduced the *horsemanship* principles, which have since become "ethological horseriding", based on scientific knowledge of how horses behave and learn. His aim is to ensure that pleasure, performance and safety are present in all equestrian activities, by making the horse/rider relationship a priority. His tagline speaks for itself: "Be the human that your horse needs". He has trained thousands of riders all over the world, and worked with some of the greatest names in equestrian sports.

AN UNPRECEDENTED SHOW

Andy will be attending the CCI 5*L in Pau for the first time this year. The eventing competition is highly demanding and requires a wide range of skills from both horses and riders, and an unwavering relationship of trust between horse and rider. It's a perfect example of ethical, high-quality horse riding. This great name in the equestrian world will give a totally unprecedented demonstration, created specially for the occasion and combining the different equestrian disciplines, to delight and entertain the spectators. An inspiring moment which is sure to appeal to many.

AN EQUAL-OPPORTUNITIES SPORT

Horse-riding is the only Olympic sport in which men and women compete in the same tests, with the same level of difficulty. It's also a perfect demonstration of gender equality, as around half the competitors are women, who are just as well represented on the podiums as their male counterparts. The recent victories by New-Zealand rider Jonelle Price (2022), British rider Laura Collett (2020) and French rider Gwendolen Fer (2017) show that women are as competitive as men, right up to the highest level. All the major individual world titles are also currently held by women. A wonderful image and an integral part of the values of equestrian sports!

AN ENVIRONMENTALLY-FRIENDLY APPROACH

Eventing is a fine example of outdoor sports, and the competition reflects this. The Domaine de Sers is a verdant woodland park in the city of Pau, and home to the municipal greenhouses. You can enjoy walking through the beautiful parkland as you make your way to the different events.

Several initiatives have been devised to contribute to preserving this beautiful setting:

- Fully online ticket office.
- Printed programmes have been replaced by a mobile app.
- Visitors are encouraged to sort and reduce waste.
